BY-LAW # 41

A BY-LAW RESPECTING DISTURBANCE BY NOISE

BE IT Enacted by the Village Council of the Village of Sussex
Corner as follows:

Clerk

1. No person, or corporation, shall make, or permit to be made, any noise within the Village of Sussex Corner likely to cause a public disturbance or otherwise disturb the inhabitants of the Village.
2. Without restricting the generality of Section 1, a noise likely to cause a public nuisance or otherwise disturb the inhabitants of the Village of Sussex Corner, between the hours of ten o'clock in the afternoon and six o'clock in the forenoon, shall be deemed to be any noise or sounds of such volume or of such nature as to cause annoyance to residents of the Village including shouting, singing, whistling, music, motor vehicles (including motorcycles and motor bikes), snowmobiles, pneumatic hammers, construction equipment and machinery, and animal noise.
3. This By-law shall not apply to pneumatic hammers, construction equipment and machinery, or vehicles of business and trade between the hours of six o'clock in the forenoon and ten o'clock in the afternoon from Monday to Saturday, inclusive.
4. This By-law shall not apply to snow removal equipment and authorized emergency vehicles or other emergency equipment.
5. Every person, or corporation, who violates any provision of the By-law is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$250.00.
