A BY-LAW RESPECTING LOITERING, BEGGING AND SOLICITING

WHEREAS the Municipalities Act, 1973, R.S.N.B., 1973, C. M-22, provides as follows:


- s. 91.1 (1) No person shall loiter unless such person, when required to do so, justifies his reason for doing so.
- s. 91.1 (2) No person shall beg or solicit from door to door or in a public place, except as may be authorized by the Village Council.
- s. 91.1 (3) Every person who commits an offence under this section is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and in default of payment, is liable to imprisonment in accordance with Subsection 31(3) of the Summary Convictions Act.


BE IT ENACTED by the Village Council for the Village of Sussex Corner as follows:

1. Sections 91.1(1), 91.1(2) and 91.1(3) of the Municipalities Act, 1973, R.S.N.B., c. M-22 are in full force and effect in the Municipality of the Village of Sussex Corner.
2. This By-law comes into effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
