Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is the Recreation Rebate?

A. A return of a portion of the fees paid by qualified applicants to participate in eligible recreation programs and services.

Q. Who is eligible to apply for the rebate?

A. Property owners and/or persons whose primary residence is within the municipal bounds of the Village of Sussex Corner are eligible to apply. Only current students, up to 18 years of age.

Q. Can I claim the rebate for my child/children?

A. Yes – if you (the applicant) are the legal parent or guardian of the child AND if your name appears on the receipt for the service in question.

Q. When and how will I receive my rehate?

A. Processing times will vary by program or service. Rebate cheques will be mailed to the address provided.
